Comments: This fax is in regards to your question of what classifications can contract and install synthetic grass. The classifications that can perform this task is many and may not be limited to these classes, it mainly depends on the contract being entered into.

These classifications are; "A" (General Engineering), "B" (General Contractor), C-27 (Landscaping), C-61/D-12 (Synthetic Products).

The "A" classification can contract/perform this scope of work per section 7056 of the Business & Professions Code, it states in part that they can contract/perform..."parks, playgrounds and other recreational works"...

The "B" classification can contract for this type of project per section 7057 of the Business & Professions Code. The "B" can be the prime contractor for any classification, as long as they sub out the work to the correct classification contractor, if they do not carry the class themselves. Or they can contract and perform the work if the contract is for two unrelated classification (not counting carpentry as one of them). The "B" can also contract/perform any carpentry class as a single trade.
